I liked it when he had the time to go over all the problems on the sheet not just the ones he felt were important for us to go over, so I guess my feedback would be to keep the same structure of choosing the most important problems for us to do and review first and then cover the rest if time allows, but if there isn't enough time it would be nice to know the answers at least and get a verbal explanation (like 30-60 sec on what we should have done, what approaches, etc) on the ones we didn't do on the board :)
